PRESIDENT'S AWARD

Twenty-plus years ago, Key Ministry's founding Executive Director took it upon herself to search the Internet for ministries with anything in common with ours. The first list wasn't very long. One organization she discovered was a ministry in Orlando working with churches to provide "Buddy Break" respite care events. My teaching and speaking brought me to Florida on a regular basis, centered around a two week tour of the state that coincided with Spring Break for our then school-age girls. On one of those trips, I managed to pry myself off my pool chair long enough to meet up with Marie Kuck, the founder of the ministry in Orlando, Nathaniel's Hope.

Marie and her husband and co-founder (Tim) come from "non-traditional" ministry backgrounds. In addition to having served as a youth pastor, Marie was a well-known Orlando TV personality, and Tim ran a boat factory. As is so often the case with folks called to disability ministry, they experienced firsthand the challenges involved in caring for a child with a significant disability. Nathaniel's legacy — and more importantly, Jesus Christ — have been greatly honored through the ministry Tim and Marie founded and continue to lead.


Buddy Break has grown into the largest church-based respite care network in the U.S. Nathaniel's Hope's Christmas toy drive and hospital visitation, along with their birthday club have been sources of joy to countless kids with disabilities in Central Florida and beyond. Our team has been fans of their work for a long time, and for many years we sought to brainstorm projects we might tackle together, but struggled to come up with anything that was a great fit. With that backdrop, Marie has been VERY persistent in trying to get our team down for Make 'm Smile - the largest annual celebration of "VIP" kids and their families in the U.S. When we needed to seek out a larger venue for DATC we finally found the "project" that made sense for our two organizations to do together. Marie got us to Make 'm Smile — but she may have underestimated the number of friends we'd be bringing with us to experience how they pull off such a large event!

Our ability to host a record number of you in Orlando this week was made possible by Marie, Tim and their team. They connected us with this magnificent church - Calvary Orlando - with the space to support all our speakers and breakouts. They brought everyone together to make this possible.

The works of God have truly been on display through Marie, Tim, their family and the entire team at Nathaniel's Hope. God willing, we'll be able to witness Nathaniel's Hope's capstone projects come to fruition in the coming years - the Hopetown residential community based on reverse inclusion that they're planning here in Orlando in conjunction with local governments and interested businesses.

We could think of no one more deserving of this award than the two of you. Thanks for all you do. It's truly been an honor for our team to serve alongside you for the past 22 years. Our 2024 President's Award winners...Marie and Tim Kuck.
